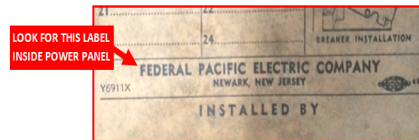

SAFETY ADVISORY ON ELECTRICAL PANELS



The Rotonda Safety Advisory addresses potential fire hazards associated with Federal Pacific Electrical Panels, commonly manufactured in North America from the 1950s to 80s. Despite appearing functional, these panels may fail to trip during over-current or short circuits, posing overheating and fire risks. The recommended advisory action is to have a licensed electrician inspect and, if necessary, replace the panel. Tenants are urged to contact their landlord promptly if they suspect any electrical issues and can find additional information on safety measures from the United States Consumer Product Safety Commission.
