PROJECT UPDATES AROUND THE PROPERTY



Several improvement projects are moving forward around the property. Work continues on the entrance canopies at Buildings 4 and 5, where crews are preparing foundations and making adjustments to utility lines. Work on replacing the canopy on Building 2 is temporarily on hold pending the progress on Buildings 4 and 5. The sliding door project is now complete at Building 4, while Building 5 is preparing for the next stage of this project. A new pedestrian gate for Greensboro is being fabricated, and the International Gatehouse is receiving updates inside and out, including painting, roof and floor assessments, and structural repairs. In Building 2's garage, cracks have been sealed and waterproofing is underway, while Building 3 is seeing balcony deck repairs and freshening of window supports and slab edges. Looking ahead, community-wide electrical maintenance is scheduled for November 17–21, with more details coming in October, along with a planned upgrade to our security access systems.


IN-UNIT SERVICES

From replacing HVAC filters and fixing faucets to adjusting door hardware and replacing light switches, our team is ready to help with many of those everyday needs. Scheduling is simple through **BuildingLink under "Maintenance – In-Unit Service"** or by contacting the Maintenance Coordinator at **703-821-0100**, ext. **711**. Labor and parts are billed after service is completed, so you only pay for what you need.



PR 22-2025 - PET AND ASSISTANCE ANIMAL POLICY



The Board of Directors has unanimously approved Policy Resolution 22-2025 (Pet and Assistance Animal Policy) as a first reading, and it is now open for a 30-day comment period through **October 10, 2025**. This policy was carefully drafted to reflect updates in Federal, State, and Local laws, as well as the Virginia Fair Housing Law, ensuring that the Rotonda's practices are consistent, enforceable, and in alignment with current legal standards regarding pets and assistance animals. 


PR 12 - VEHICLE POLICY


CHAIR YOGA - NOW ON WEDNESDAYS & FRIDAYS
